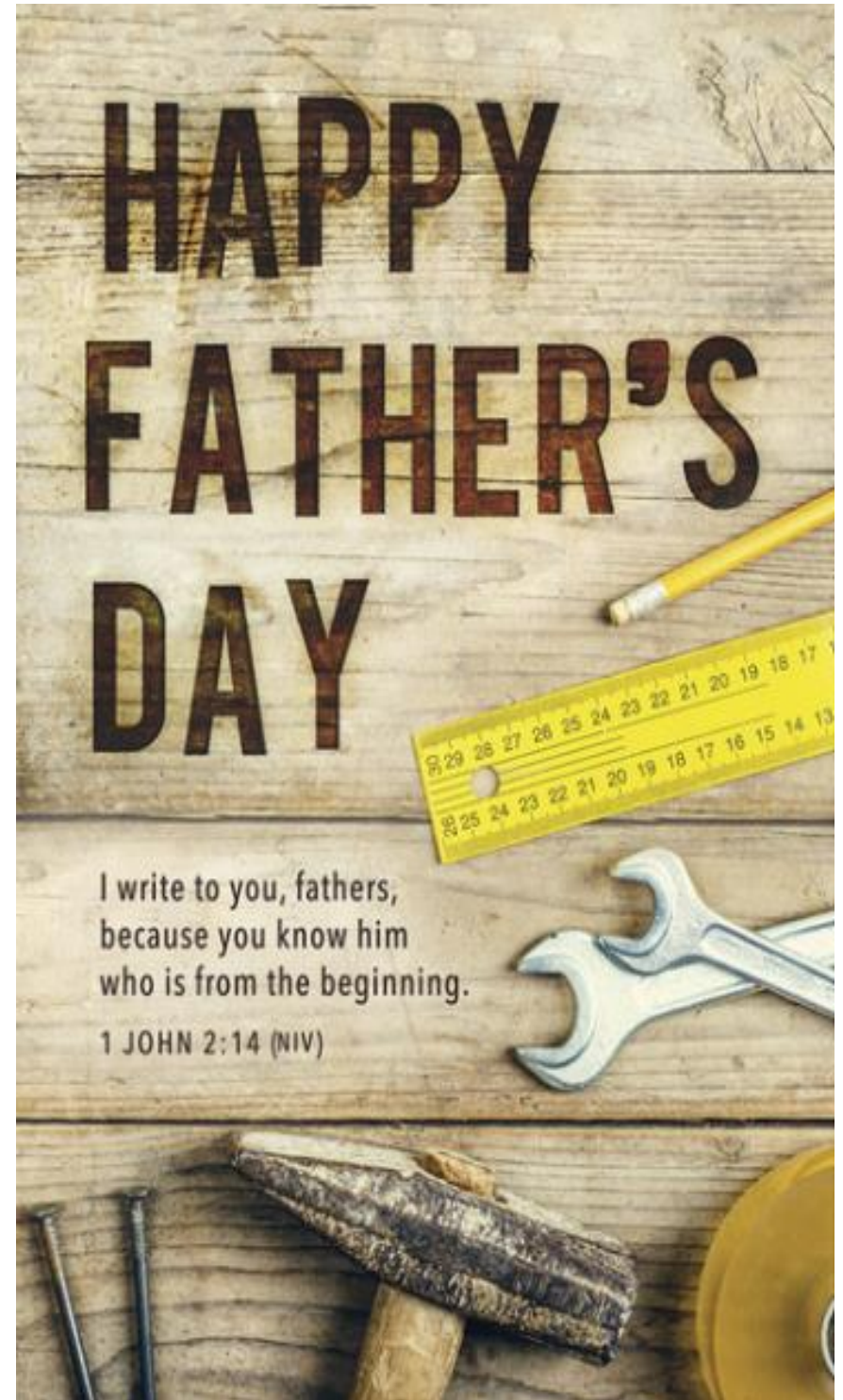

## SIGNIFICANT ITEMS

### Church Council Meeting - June 4, 2024

1. Council reviewed financial reports for May and the third quarter.
2. Council agreed to contract with Paul Miller for \$8900.00 to replace the front sidewalk from the front ramp to the parking lot on the North side of the building, approx. 40-45 feet. We also agreed to contract with him to repair the steps and entryway on the South side of the church at a cost of \$2100.00.
3. The Pastor Search Committee gave an update.
4. John reminded us that his last sermon will be on July 7.
5. John also has received words of appreciation from the local school district for the kids' activities that our church has provided for the whole community, such as the Easter Egg Hunt, Bible School, end-of-school Carnival, etc.
6. Michelle reminded us of upcoming kids' activities. The end-of-school carnival will be held on Saturday. And a few weeks after that, there will be a float in the Grantsville Days Parade.
