AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is located at the back of the church near the elevator.

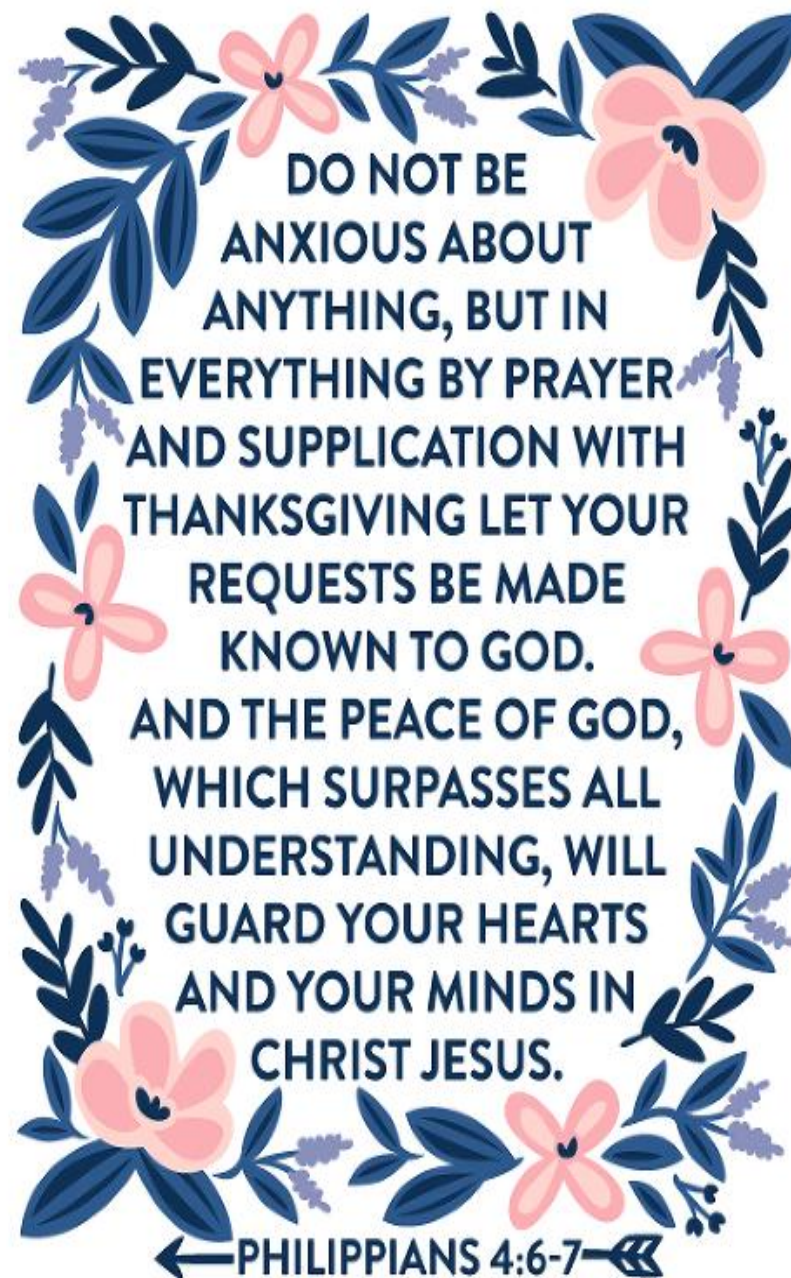
