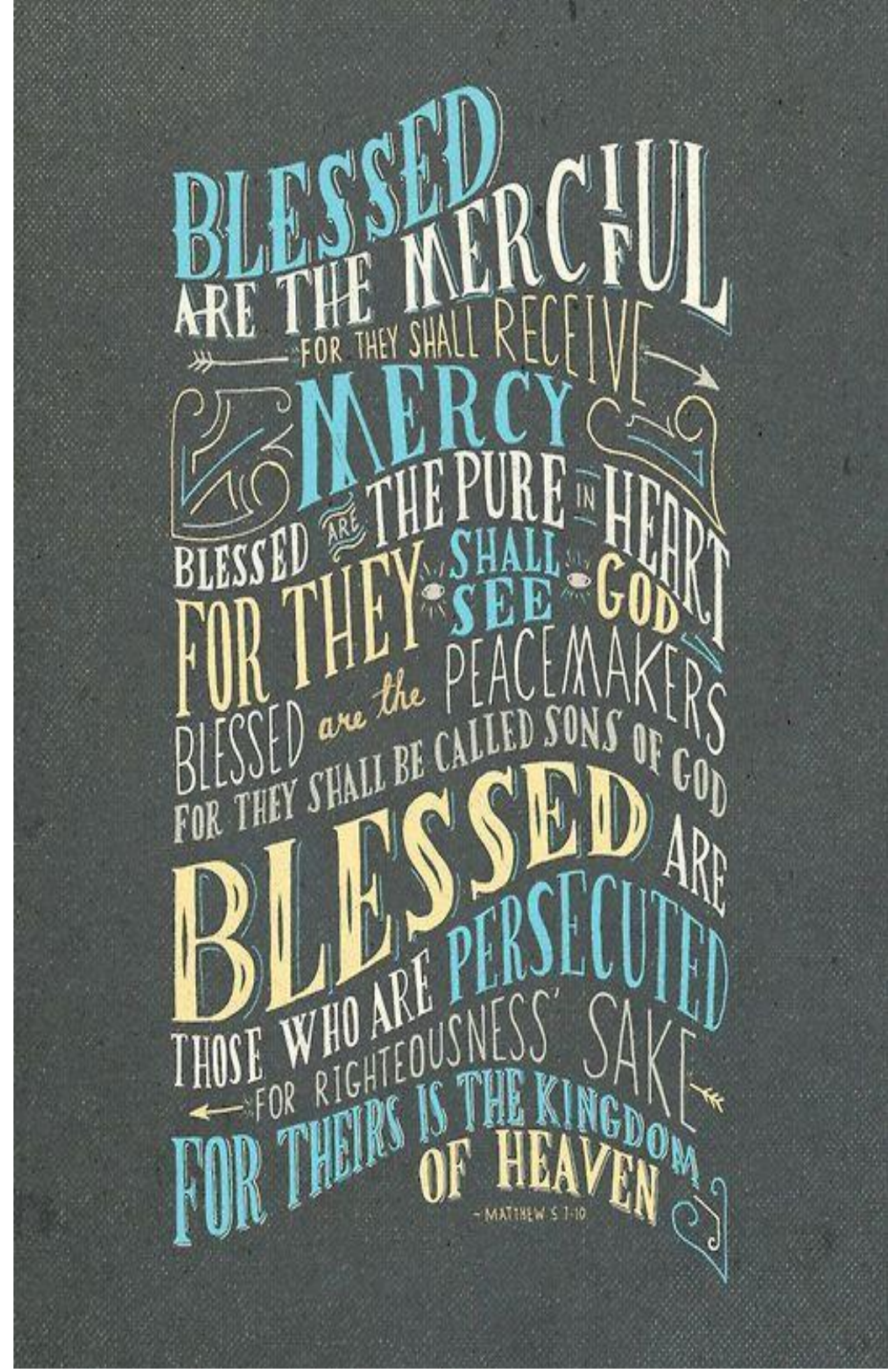
AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is located at the back of the church near the elevator.

1. Phoebe Wiley led devotions from Romans 12:9-18 and Matthew 5:42-45. She read writing by Arthur Brooks that talked about a "crisis of contempt." Brooks points out that contempt has become a habit in our society. He suggests that the way to break contempt is to ask God to give the strength and to remove the contempt in our heart, to make a commitment to another person to reject contempt, and to go out looking for contempt – run to the darkness and bring your light!
2. Arrangements have been made to hold communion at Goodwill on February 25th at 10:30AM.
3. Fortress Men's Choir of Belleview, IL United Methodist Church offered to sing during our worship service on October 4, 2020 (Folk Festival Weekend). The committee is supportive of the group coming and suggested that it be organized through the Worship Committee.
4. John reported that several Sunday School classes have responded to his request to organize an event for our church family to get together, and where visitors can be invited.
5. The meeting adjourned following a time of prayer.

Significant items for Elders meeting 3/9/2020

1. Ken Detrick led the group in devotions from Daniel chapter 6. He encouraged the group that if we believe and trust in God, we too can be like Daniel. Ken recognized that we too have "lions" in our own life that we need to face.
