**AED (Automated External Defibrillator)** is located at the back of the church near the elevator.

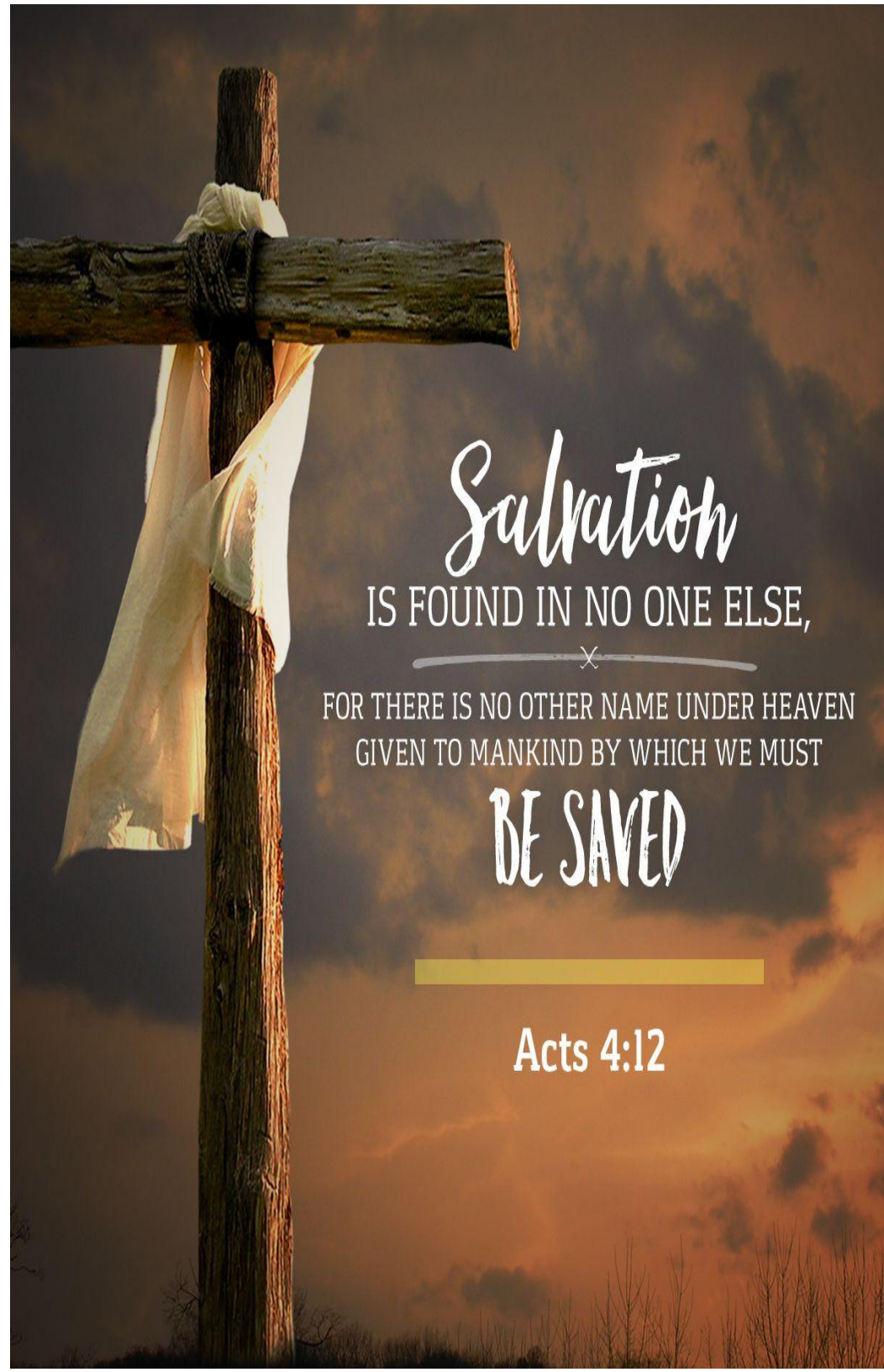
