
AED (Automated External Defibrillator) is located at the back of the church near the elevator.

Update from Naomi Tice from Tuesday, August 18, 2020.

“I got my new Australian visa today! Huge sigh of relief—I can stay here until January 21, 2021 if I absolutely need to. But hopefully I won’t! Tentative plans right now are to leave here on Sept. 14 and arrive at the Frankfurt Airport in Germany on Sept. 15. There’s a COVID testing site at the Frankfurt Airport, and I should get my test results within 6 hours. Assuming I test negative, I won’t need to quarantine. If I do end up needing to quarantine, I should finish my two weeks a few days before language classes start at the beginning of October.

I’ll be living with MMN workers David and Sophie Lapp Jost and several other people in the Hausgemeinschaft, a communal house in Bammental located just across the street from the Mennonite Church (and also close to the Christliche Dientse office), and my first five months of work will be to learn German. David has kindly offered to do some Zoom tutoring with me before I arrive, and we had our first lesson last week. Apparently my online classes plus past language training for voice lessons and singing in choirs has paid off, because he said my pronunciation is “zehr gut!”

I’ll let you know once I know more firm details, but up until now, everything has been rather up in the air!”
