Guidelines for Inside Church

Our basic principles:

1. We want to be as safe as possible.
2. We want everyone to feel safe and welcome

Our guidelines for worshipping inside again:

1. In accordance with CDC guidelines and out of respect for the vulnerable in our church family and for the safety of the community as well, we ask everyone to wear a mask and try to maintain social distance. Masks will be provided at the entrance to the Sanctuary if you need one. Hand sanitizer will also be available at all the entrances to the Sanctuary.
2. The ushers will provide you with guidance for seating. We will use every other row of the pews. We ask that you sit on the outside ends of the pews and in the middle with no more than 7 people on each pew. We realize that you may not be able to sit where you typically do, but we hope this small inconvenience will not be an issue.
3. We will continue to use the offering box placed at the entrance to the Sanctuary as we have done throughout our outdoor services.
4. At the conclusion of the service, we ask that you exit the Church via the 5 exit doors in the Sanctuary (One on each side of the Sanctuary, the front doors, by the piano and via the elevator).
5. If you want to visit others, please do so outside the sanctuary either before or after the service.
6. We want everyone to participate in our worship service. However we understand that some feel the need for more physical space as we move back indoors. So, we've set aside space for you to do this. The last two rows on each side of the Sanctuary and the balcony are reserved for you. Alternatively, we invite you to listen to the service through the speakers in the basement. Of course, you can always sit outside in your car and listen to the service at 87.9 FM. Whatever your decision, we want you to know that you are part of our family.
7. Finally, if you are not feeling well any Sunday. Please stay at home and take care of yourself. We understand. If there is something we can do to help if you're sick, please let us know.

Of course, these can change at any point depending on changes in the environment around us.
