Church Council Meeting
February 10, 2021

1. The new church laptop has been received and is being prepared for use.
2. Work continues on the church website.
3. Council agreed to enter into a lease for a new copier.
4. The folding machine in the church office will need to be replaced.
5. Council agreed to purchase and Erie Secure insurance policy to replace the current Ultraflex policy as well as the current Catastrophic Business policy. There will be more coverage, and the cost will be nearly the same as before.
6. Council will consider repairs to the retaining wall at the ramp at the rear gym entrance as well as upgrades to the outdoor stage area that we used last summer.
