Springs Mennonite Church is Handicap Accessible



¹⁸ *Against all hope, Abraham in hope believed and so became the father of many nations, just as it had been said to him, “So shall your offspring be.”*¹⁹ *Without weakening in his faith, he faced the fact that his body was as good as dead—since he was about a hundred years old—and that Sarah’s womb was also dead.*²⁰ *Yet he did not waver through unbelief regarding the promise of God, but was strengthened in his faith and gave glory to God,*²¹ *being fully persuaded that God had power to do what he had promised.*²² *This is why “it was credited to him as righteousness.”*²³ *The words “it was credited to him” were written not for him alone,*²⁴ *but also for us, to whom God will credit righteousness—for us who believe in him who raised Jesus our Lord from the dead.*²⁵ *He was delivered over to death for our sins and was raised to life for our justification.*
