**Springs Mennonite Church is Handicap Accessible**

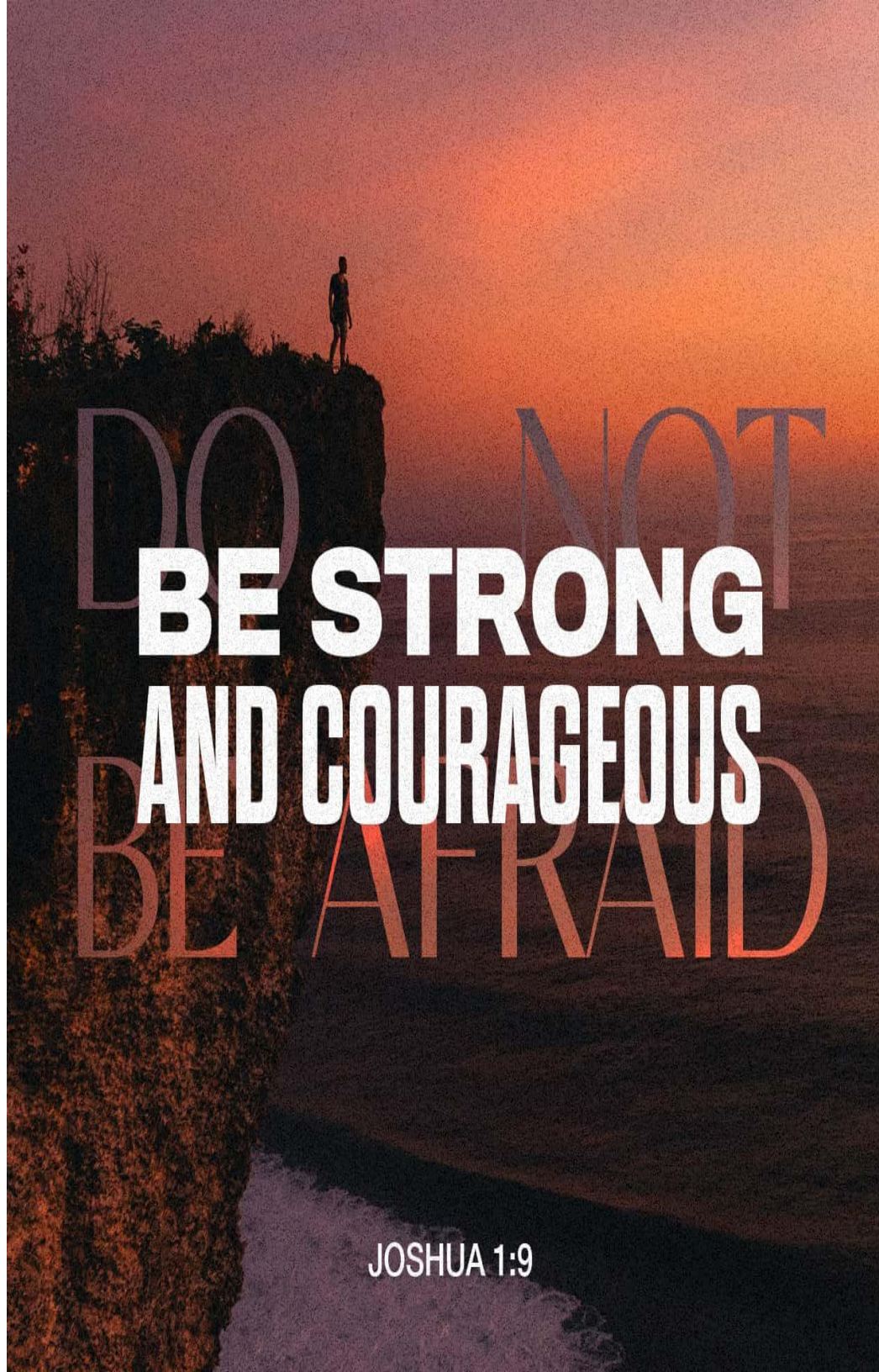

## **Joshua 1:2-9**

<sup>2</sup> “Moses my servant is dead. Now then, you and all these people, get ready to cross the Jordan River into the land I am about to give to them—to the Israelites. <sup>3</sup> I will give you every place where you set your foot, as I promised Moses. <sup>4</sup> Your territory will extend from the desert to Lebanon, and from the great river, the Euphrates—all the Hittite country—to the Mediterranean Sea in the west. <sup>5</sup> No one will be able to stand against you all the days of your life. 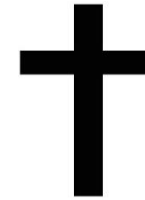
**There will be no Bible school this year because of uncertainty around the Coronavirus Pandemic.**
