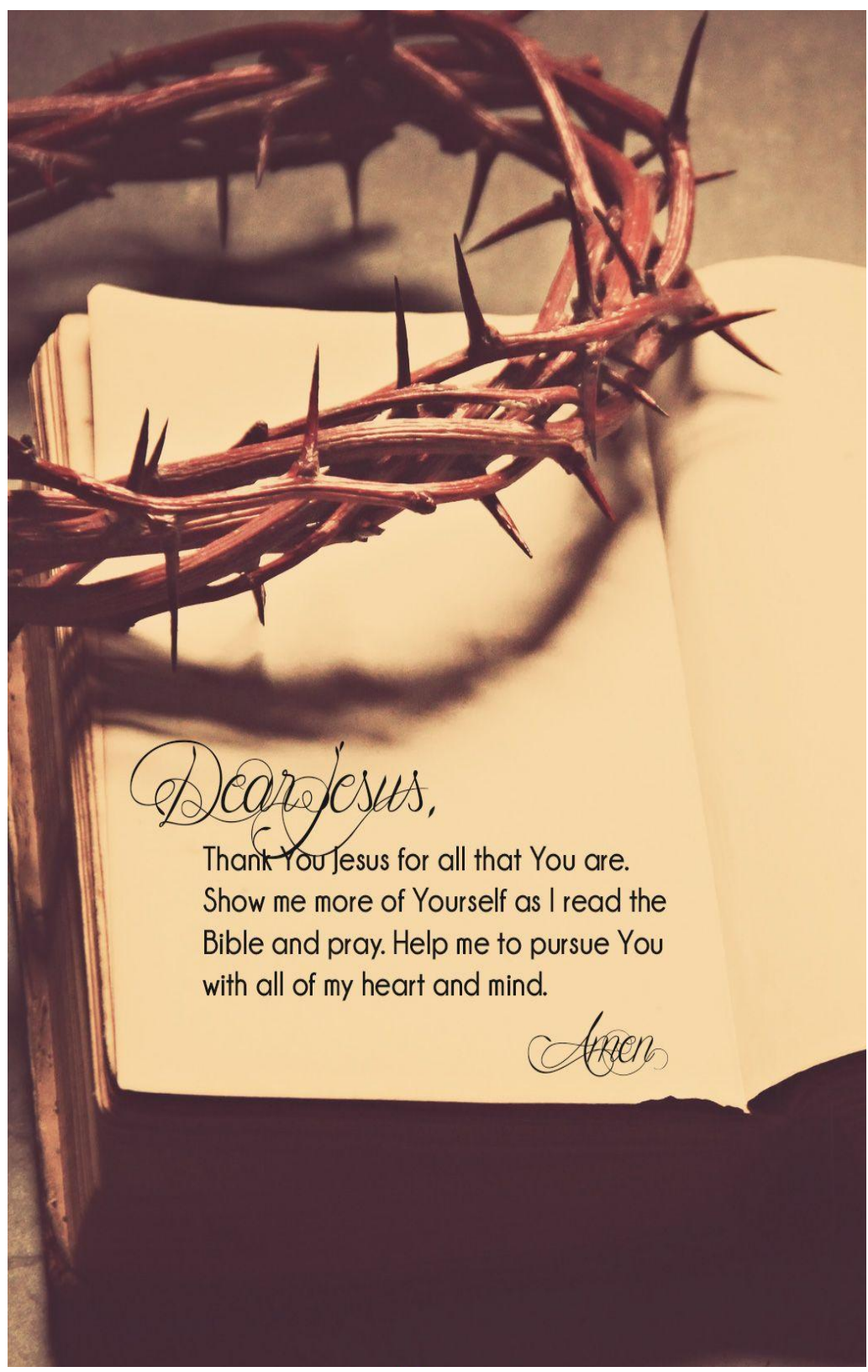

July 6, 2021

1. The fourth quarter offering for Allegheny Mennonite Conference will be held on July 18.
2. Some final details were discussed regarding the Tri-State Relief Sale to be held here on July 17.
3. A boiler inspection has been done on the furnace and there will need to be some repairs.
4. Because of volunteer labor and some donated materials, the church only had to buy the paver blocks and mortar for the rear stage / patio area. Total cost was only \$1309.00.
5. Council-appointed positions were discussed and those persons will be contacted to see if they will continue in their current positions.
6. Council was asked to review the Building & Property Use Agreement and the By-Laws document prior to next meeting to see what changes might be needed upon revision.
7. WMSC will begin meeting weekly here at the church on Wednesday, July 7.
