Church Council Meeting

October 5, 2021

1. Oct. 17 will be this quarter's special offering for Allegheny Mennonite Conference. A minimum of \$2000 and a maximum of \$5000 for each quarter will be sent to AMC, with \$500 per quarter to be designated for Mennonite Mission Network and \$500 for Mennonite Education as was done last year.
2. Designations for the special Missions Offering to be held sometime in November will be the same as last year with \$1000 going to 3 separate food banks – Garrett Co. Food Bank, Somerset Co. Food Bank, and Somerset Mobile Food Bank. The balance of the Missions Offering will be split with 60% going to MCC and 40% going to MDS.
3. The agenda for the Congregational Meeting to be held on October 26 at 7 PM will be as follows:
  - 1) Review of Annual Report Booklet
  - 2) Approval of the Proposed Church Budget for 2021-22
  - 3) Vote on the changes to the by-laws
4. Sunday School Class #7 has resumed meeting in the gym on Sunday mornings.
5. Commendation was mentioned for the people who are doing the outdoor movie nights.
